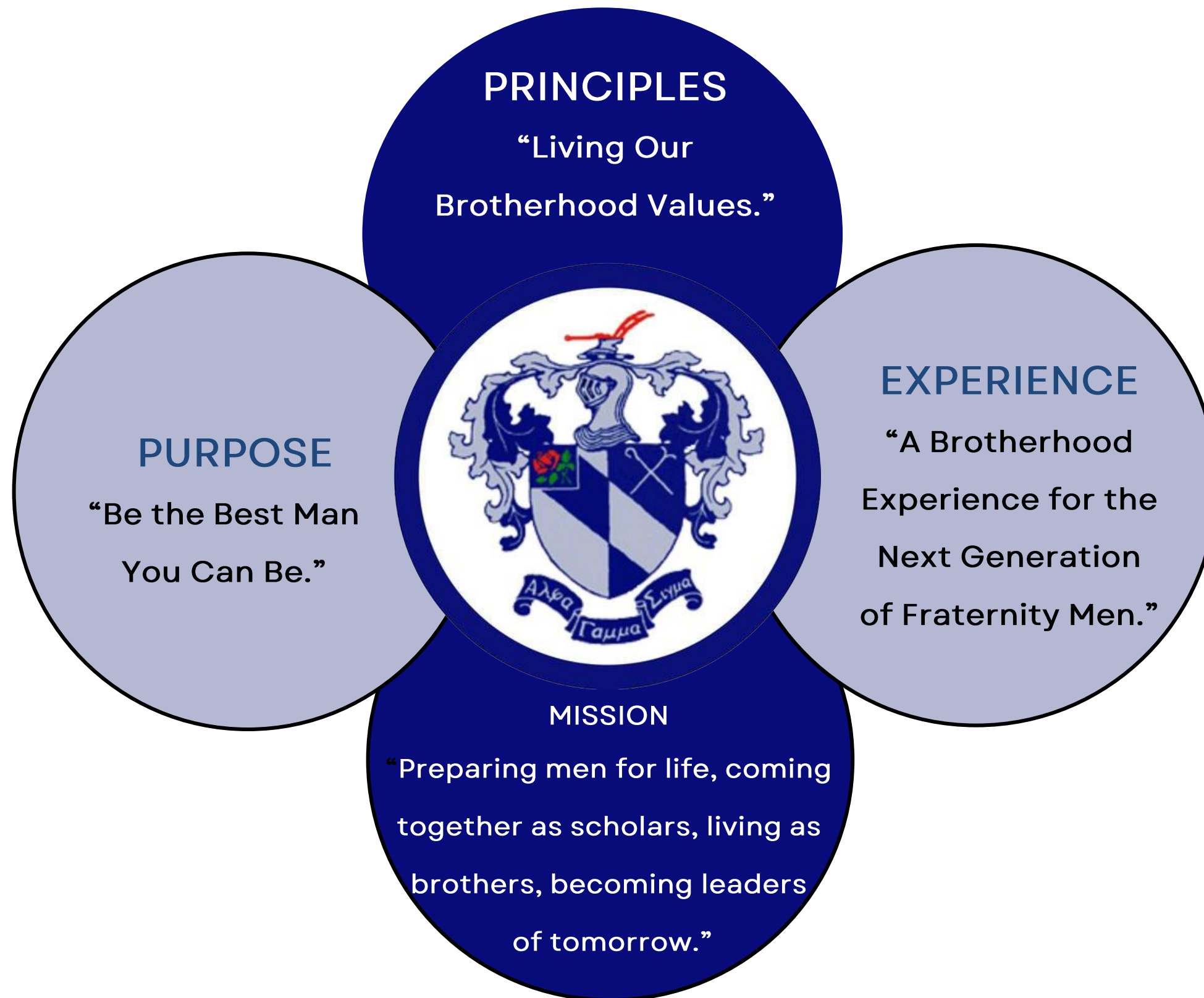

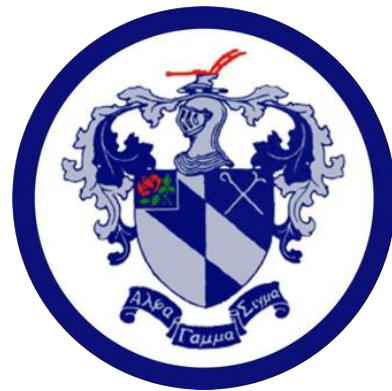

AGS members spent spring break in Mexico serving the less fortunate from assisting at an orphanage to helping at a women's home.



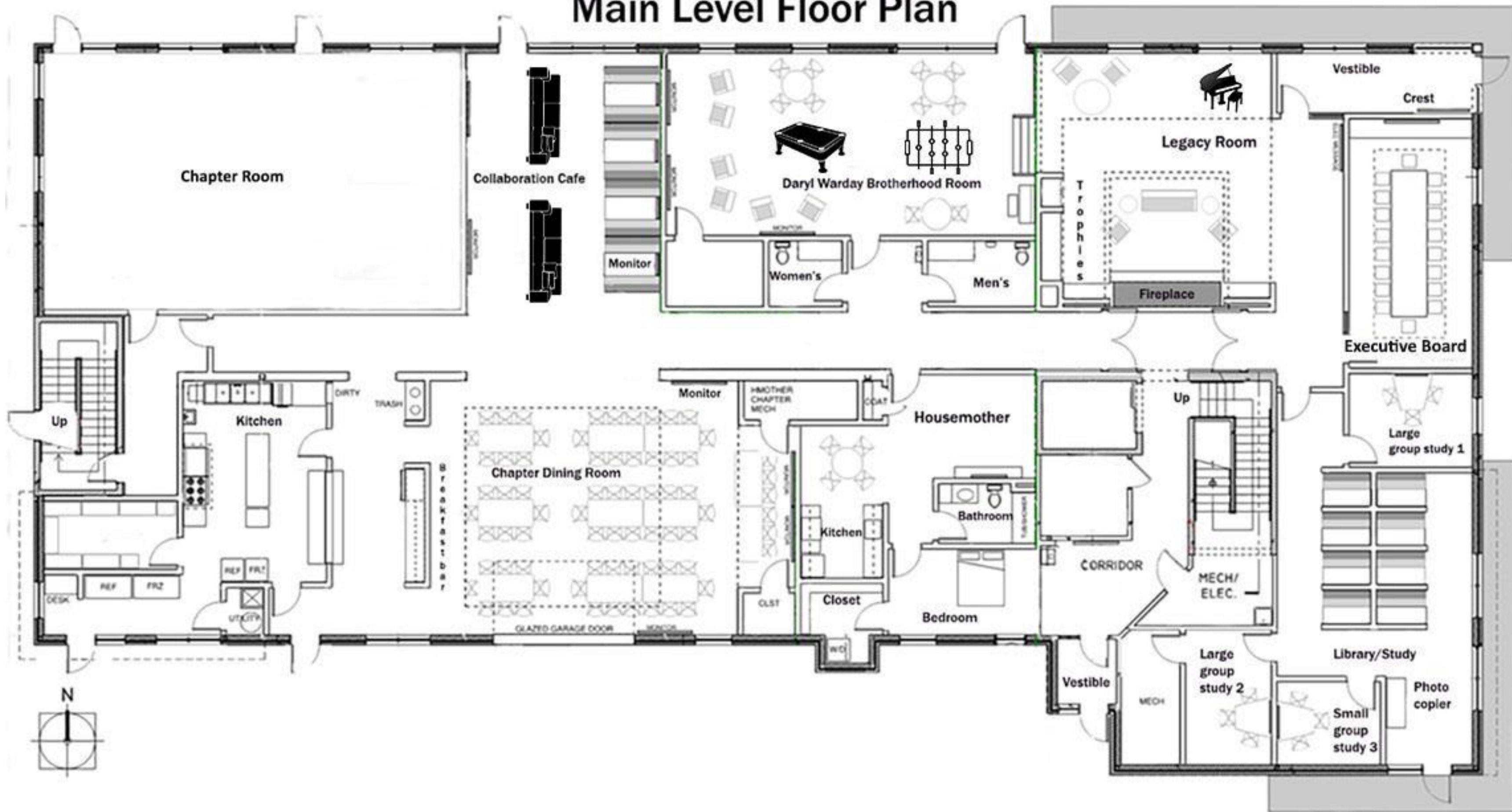

Main Level Floor Plan

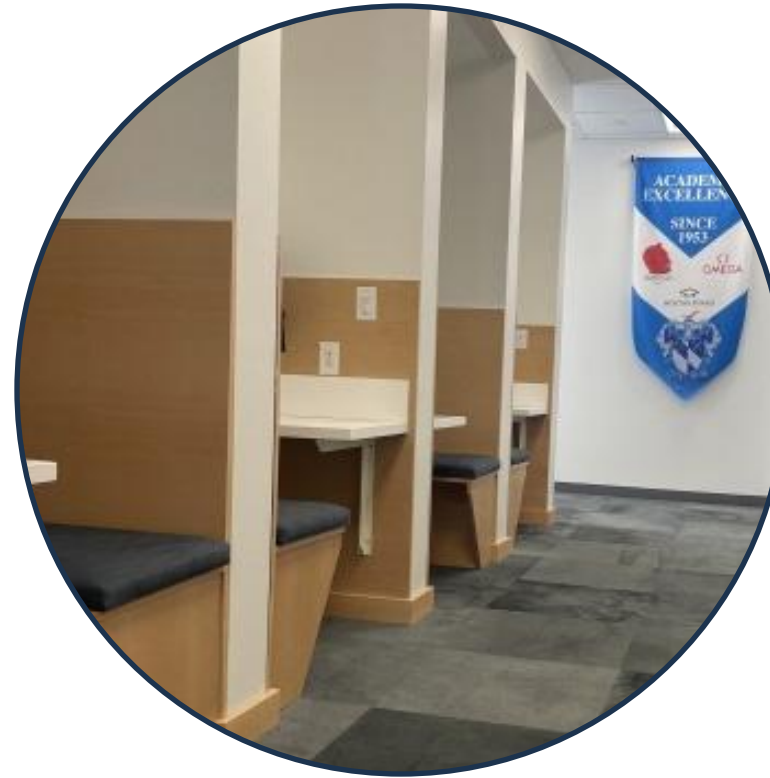

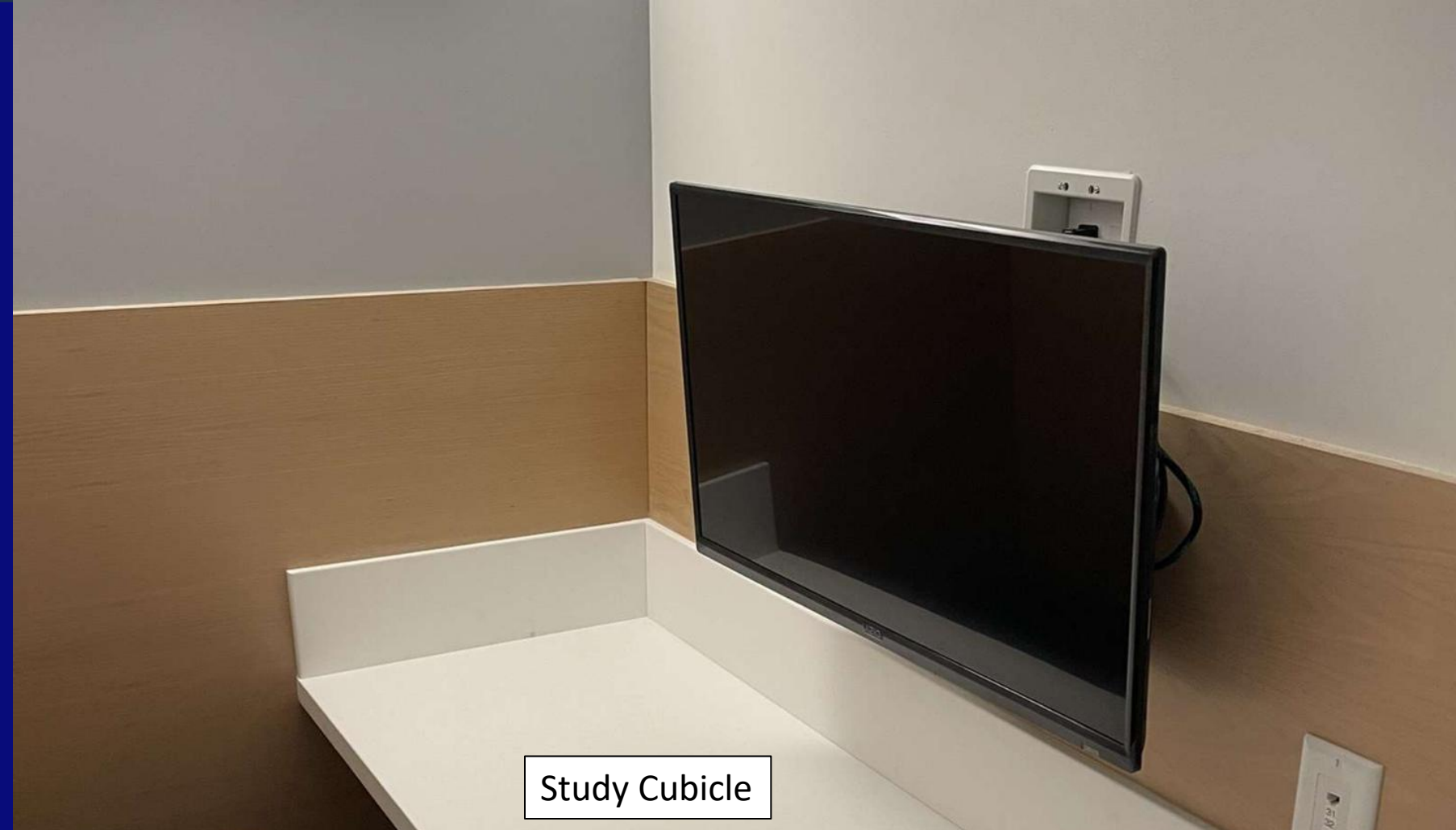

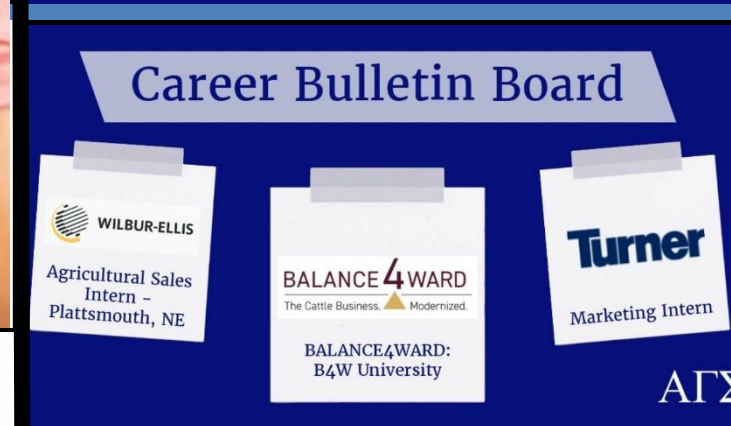
